Sin—Someone Sins Against You

- I. Introduction
 - A. What emotion do you normally feel when someone sins against you?
 - B. Whose sin normally hurts you the most?
 - C. Do you treat a saved person's sin differently than the unsaved? Why?
 - D. If an unsaved person sins against you, what should you do?
- II. Scripture
 - A. A Brother **Sins** against you (A Maximum of 3 Steps, up to Church Discipline)
 - <u>Luk. 17:3-4</u>—"3-Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, <u>rebuke him</u>; and if he repent, <u>forgive him</u>. 4-And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt <u>forgive him</u>."
 - <u>Mat. 18:15-17</u>—"15-Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, <u>go</u> and <u>tell him his fault between thee and him alone</u>: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. 16-But if he will not hear thee, then <u>take with thee one or</u> <u>two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be</u> <u>established</u>. 17-And if he shall neglect to hear them, <u>tell it unto the church</u>: but if he neglect to hear the church, let <u>him be unto thee as an heathen man</u> and a publican."
 - 1. Mat. 18:15 (Step 1—Go humbly admonish them of their sin alone).
 - 2. <u>Mat. 18:16</u> (Step 2—Go humbly admonish them of their sin with 1 or 2 witnesses).
 - 3. *Mat. 18:17* (Step 3—Go humbly admonish them of their sin before the Church).
