"1Ti. 6:1-2— 1-Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honor, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed. 2-And they that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort." "Tit. 2:9-10—9-Exhort servants to be obedient unto their own masters, and to please them well in all things; not answering again; 10-Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things."
