  - B. Meaning (What is Praise): American Heritage Dictionary says, "1. An expression of warm approval or admiration. 2. The extolling of a deity, ruler, or hero. -v praised, praising. 1. To express warm approval of or admiration for; commend; applaud. 2. To extol or exalt; worship."
  - C. Select Observations.
    - 1. Psa. 22:26—"The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek Him: your heart shall live forever."
    - 2. Psa. 111:1—"I will praise the LORD with my whole heart."
    - 3. **Psa. 150:6**—"Let everything that hath breath praise the LORD."
    - 4. Isa. 61:3—"To appoint...the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness."
    - 5. Eph. 1:12—"That we should be to the praise of His glory, who first trusted in Christ."
    - 6. Php. 4:8—"...if there be any praise, think on these things."
    - 7. Heb. 13:15—"By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name"

And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, 'Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise'?")</li> <li>Seek "the Praise of G," not man (John 12:43—"For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God." Rom. 2:29—"But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God." 1Co. 4:5—"Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, Who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.")</li> <li>Those who do not praise God become V, F, and D their heart (Rom. 1:21—"Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.")</li> </ol>
