- A. Suffering/persecution for being godly.
  - 1. 2Ti. 3:12—"Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution."
  - 2. 1Th. 2:15—"Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men."
- B. Blessings when persecuted for being godly.
  - 1. Mat. 5:10-12—"10-Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11-Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for My sake. 12-Rejoice and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you."

- 2. 1Pe. 3:14—"But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled."
- C. Christians Need Not Fear Persecution.
  - 1. **2Ti. 1:7**—"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."
  - 2. Rom. 8:15—"For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father."
  - 3. **Deu. 31:6**—"Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee."
  - 4. Jos. 1:9—"Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest."
  - 5. **Psa. 31:24**—"**Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.**"
  - 6. Act 4:29, 31—"29-And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto Thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak Thy Word. 31-And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the Word of God with boldness."
- D. Is it Loving to Speak Up or Shut up?
  - 1. **Pro. 6:23**—"For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life."
  - 2. **Pro. 9:8-9**—"8-Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee. 9-Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning."
  - 3. **Pro. 27:5-6**—"5-**Open rebuke** is better than secret love. 6-Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful."

- 4. **Pro. 28:23**—"He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more favor than he that flattereth with the tongue."
- 5. Lev. 19:17—"Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbor, and not suffer sin upon him."
- 6. **Psa. 141:5**—"Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities."
- 7. Tit. 1:13—"This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith."
- 8. Rev 3:19—"As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent."
