 - 2. Mat. 5:23-26—"23-Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; 24-Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift. 25-Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison. 26-Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing."
 - 3. 2Co. 5:18-20—"18-And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19-To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 20-Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God."
