 - 2. **2Ki. 2:11**—"...a chariot of fire, and horses of fire...and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven."
- B. **Special Resurrections** (saw death and were resurrected, but also saw death again).
 - 1. 1Ki. 17:17-24—"The soul of the child came into him again, and he revived."
 - 2. **2Ki. 4:32-36**—"The child was dead...the child opened his eyes."
 - 3. 2Ki. 13:20-21—"...As they were burying a man...when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet."
 - 4. Luk. 7:12-15—"...there was a dead man carried out...And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother."
 - 5. Mat. 27:52-53—"And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose. And came out of the graves after His resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many."
 - 6. Joh. 11:39-44—"...he hath been dead four days...he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, 'Loose him, and let him go.'"
 - 7. Act. 9:36-42—"...a disciple named Tabitha...was sick, and died...she opened her eyes...she sat up...presented her alive."
 - 8. Rev. 11:1-13—"...their dead bodies...after three days and a half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet...and they ascended up to heaven in a cloud..."
