Miraculous ability, given to equip Church believers, to serve God and others, to build up the Church.

II. Scripture.

- A. **What type of gift(s)** has God given? **Who gets** these gifts? **When do they get** these gifts?
 1. **Natural gifts, talents, or abilities**—Gifts that are **genetic** (physical traits like gender, size, body-type, and the corresponding natural leanings and predispositions) and **environmentally** shaped, chosen, educated, rewarded, and trained (through parents, diet, exercise, school, hard-work, coaching/mentoring, and discipline). The unsaved recognize these gifts from either nature or nurture. These gifts, talents, and abilities are expressed through the framework of their personality. **All** (both saved and unsaved) get these gifts. God gives these gifts **at conception and a person develops them throughout their life.**
 2. **Supernatural gifts, talents, or abilities**—Those gifts that are given supernaturally by God. Someone (with a low or at least not a high-functioning natural gift or training) immediately exhibits a high-functioning gift that is only explained by supernatural intervention. In the OT, these may have been temporary supernatural gifts like those evidenced by prophets to receive and reveal God’s Word and perform healings, and even in a few cases temporarily raise someone from the dead.
- B. **Purpose** of “the spiritual **Gifts**?”
 1. **sGs**—miraculously confirmed **God’s Word and Apostles**. **Mar. 16:20**—“**And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word with signs following. Amen.**”
 2. **sGs**—miraculously confirmed **the Church Start**.
 3. **sGs**—miraculous **sign to believers and unbelievers**. **1Co. 14:21-22**—“²¹**In the law it is written, 'With men of other tongues**

*and other lips will I speak unto this people; and yet for all that will they not hear me,' saith the Lord. 22 Wherefore tongues are for a **sign**, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe." Isa. 28:11—"For with stammering lips and another tongue will He speak to this people."*

4. sGs—miraculous ability to profit/edify/build up the Church.
1Co. 12:7—"But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal." 1Co. 14:3-5, 12, 17, 26—"3But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. 4He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. 5I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying. 12Even so ye, forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church. 17For thou verily givest thanks well, but the other is not edified. 26How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying."
5. sGs—miraculous ability to unite diversely gifted members to care for the Church.
1Co. 12:25-27—"25That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another. 26And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it. 27Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular."
